*Steven Kipnis, MD, FACP, DFASAM*

*Topic: Insights Into the Use/Misuse of Opiates and Synthetic Marijuana*

Steven Kipnis, MD, FACP, DFASAM received his MD from the University of Miami School of Medicine and continued his education with a residency and fellowship in Internal and Pulmonary Medicine at Nassau County Medical Center. He is board certified in Internal Medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine and received his certification in Addiction Medicine from the American Society of Addiction Medicine. Dr. Kipnis was elected to Fellowship status in the American College of Physicians and received his Fellowship from the American Society of Addiction Medicine, with a Distinguished Fellow designation. Dr. Kipnis is a diplomat of the American Board of Addiction Medicine (ABAM). He was appointed to the faculty of Albany Medical College as a Clinical Associate Professor of Medicine. Dr. Kipnis served as the Medical Director of the NYS Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services from 2000 to 2014. He was recently elected to the Board of the NYSAM (New York Society of Addiction Medicine).
